

VANGUARD CELEBRATES GROUNDBREAKING FOR DEUTSCHE BANK'S SOLAR PROJECT EXPANSION IN PISCATAWAY

Vanguard joined Deutsche Bank, Jones Lang LaSalle and local officials for a Groundbreaking Ceremony on October 16 for the second phase of the bank's solar electric array in Piscataway, New Jersey. The 1.267 MW project will feature the addition of rooftop solar panels and the construction of a carport to accommodate additional solar modules. Earlier this year, Vanguard designed and constructed a 250.51-kilowatt solar photovoltaic system on the roof of the facility. Phase II is expected to be completed by December of 2010 and Deutsche Bank's goal is to be net-zero electric once the entire project is deployed.
